5	WHEREAS, food cart vending has become an increasingly popular mode of
6	providing culturally-diverse and varied food options to the public, and
7	WHEREAS, food cart vending attracts foot traffic to commercial districts and
8	creates a more vibrant retail business climate, and
9	WHEREAS, food cart vending improves public safety by encouraging pedestrian
10	activity and increasing eyes on the streets, and
11	WHEREAS, Public Health - Seattle & King County currently limits menu options
12	for food carts to non-potentially hazardous foods, hot dogs and espresso drinks, and
13	WHEREAS, the Board of Health supports the stated commitment of the Public
14	Health - Seattle & King County Food Protection Program to implement the proposed plan
15	review process to consider proposals from food cart vendors to serve a wider variety of
16	menu options to the public, and
17	WHEREAS, the Public Health - Seattle & King County Food Protection Program
18	has developed a risk-based approach to evaluating and approving a greater variety of

- 19 food options to be served by food cart businesses while maintaining public health and
- 20 safety;
