1	A RESOLUTION calling on the Congress and the Joint
2	Select Committee on Deficit Reduction to preserve funding
3	for the federal Prevention and Public Health Fund.
4	WHEREAS, among the historic provisions of the Affordable Care Act was the
5	recognition that our nation must begin to invest in prevention to save money and improve
6	health for the long-term, and
7	WHEREAS, the Affordable Care Act created the Prevention and Public Health
8	Fund, an unprecedented investment of \$16.5 billion over ten years (2011-2020) in
9	proven, effective programs to prevent diseases and injury, and
10	WHEREAS, seventy-five percent of all health care costs in our country are spent
11	on the treatment of chronic diseases, many of which could be prevented, and
12	WHEREAS, preventing disease and injury is the most effective, common sense
13	way to improve health, to reduce health care costs and to make the United States
14	economy stronger, and
15	WHEREAS, residents in Washington state, tribes, King County and neighboring
16	counties have the opportunity to directly benefit from this investment in prevention, and
17	WHEREAS, continuing to invest in health will not only improve health outcomes
18	but also improve the bottom line for businesses by lowering health care costs, reducing
19	absenteeism and improving productivity, and

20	WHEREAS, in a public opinion survey conducted by the Robert Wood Johnson
21	Foundation, seventy-one percent of Americans favored an increased investment in
22	disease prevention, and
23	WHEREAS, now is the time to increase, rather than decrease, our ability to
24	adequately protect the health of all American people and all King County residents;
25	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Health of King
