


Baring Bridge

Soil testing and river work



King County

Weekdays only 7 AM to 7 PM



King County will drill for soil samples and conduct river survey work near the Baring Bridge. This work may be loud.

Soil experts will use large truck-mounted auger drills and impact samplers to obtain soil samples from 50 to 75 feet under the ground.

Surveyors will wade along the South Fork Skykomish River and Index Creek riverbanks to take pictures and measurements. They also will fly a drone along the South Fork Skykomish River to take aerial photos. Crews will not fly over neighboring property.

Baring Bridge Replacement Project

The Baring Bridge, originally built in 1930, provides sole access to 170 properties and 40 residences.

The bridge has had many repairs and retrofits over its nine decades and is severely load-restricted for safety. It needs to be replaced.

King County plans to replace the existing timber structure with a wider steel truss bridge.

Construction is scheduled to begin in 2024 and last through 2026.
