

Effective June 13, 2022, the following are the attendance requirements in all East Division Courtrooms in the Bellevue, Redmond, and Issaquah Courthouses, by hearing type:

Arraignment:

- DV and DUI cases: All parties must appear IN PERSON
- Waivable Offenses: Defendants may appear via Zoom. If a defendant appears in person, their attorney must also attend in person.

Pre Trial Hearings:

• Defendants may appear in person or via Zoom. If a defendant appears in person, their attorney must also attend in person.

Testimonial Motions:

• All parties must appear in person.

Trials:

• All parties must appear in person.

Entry of Guilty Plea, Stipulated Order of Continuance, or Deferred Prosecution:

• All parties must appear in person.

Sentencing:

• All parties must appear in person.

Review Hearings:

• Defendants may appear in person or via Zoom. If a defendant appears in person, their attorney must also attend in person.

Jury Call:

• Defendants may appear in person or via Zoom. If a defendant appears in person, their attorney must also attend in person.

Infractions:

• All parties may appear via Zoom, in person, or by telephone. If a defendant appears in person, their attorney must also attend in person.

Protection Order Hearings:

- All parties may appear via Zoom, in person, or by telephone. If a party appears in person, their attorney must also attend in person.
- <u>NOTE</u>: Exceptions will only be permitted in exceptional circumstances and for good cause. Requests for exceptions will only be considered by written motion filed <u>in advance</u> of the hearing and shall be considered by the Judge on whose calendar the hearing is set.
