EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A. Fourth Quarter 2012 Highlights

This report provides fourth quarter 2012 utilization information for the 131 park-and-ride (P&R) facilities currently operating in the King County Metro Transit (Metro) service area. These P&R's represent a total capacity of 25,143 parking spaces, an increase of 33 spaces from fourth quarter 2011. During this quarter, 19,212 spaces were used on an average daily basis, resulting in an average utilization rate of 76 percent of available parking capacity. More than half of the 65 permanent P&R's averaged 80 percent or higher daily utilization during the fourth quarter.

Overall P&R use rose by 663 vehicles (four percent) in the fourth quarter over the same quarter the previous year, with permanent P&R use increasing by 535 vehicles and leased P&R use increasing by 128 vehicles.

The local economy and job growth continues to improve, with some sectors stronger than others and occasional mixed economic signals. Park-and-ride utilization is now surpassing the level four years ago prior to the economic recession, with demand strongest among suburban commuters, especially on the eastside. The data continues to demonstrate strong linkages between P&R usage, transit ridership, economic growth and the cost of fuel.

During the fourth quarter, the retail price of gasoline began the quarter at \$4.09 per gallon, dropped steadily throughout November, leveled off in December and ended the quarter at \$3.46 per gallon. The quarter closed with gas prices \$0.63 per gallon (or 15 percent) lower than at the beginning of the quarter, and \$0.07 per gallon (or two percent) lower than the gas price of \$3.53/gallon in December 2011. *

B. Park-and-Ride Changes

Maple Valley Town Square leased P&R lot opened October 1st in Maple Valley for public access to commuter parking for transit. See page 6 for details.

C. Construction Updates and Projects of Interest

Evergreen Point Bridge P&R – A temporary Evergreen Point Bridge P&R lot of 19 stalls is located on the northside of SR-520 for the approximately two-year Eastside Transit and HOV construction project. The former permanent P&R location is currently being used for construction staging. The original 50-stall capacity will be restored, creating a new P&R lot on the SR-520 lid in late 2013.

South Kirkland Park-and-Ride TOD/Expansion Project – The Transit Oriented Development (TOD) project will add 250 parking spaces, increasing the P&R lot to about 850 spaces when the transit portion is complete. In addition, the project includes:

- (1) a new roadway through the property with improved transit access and bus zones;
- (2) a signal at 108th Avenue NE and NE 38th Place; and
- (3) a private mixed-use housing project on a portion of the current P&R site.

The transit portion, including the new loop roadway, transit center, 532-stall P&R garage and surface parking, is scheduled to be complete and the garage open in summer 2013. The entire TOD construction project will last through December 2014, approximately 2-1/2 years.

Construction

The first phase of the project constructed a temporary transit facility and the western part of the new transit loop roadway. Phase 1A lasted 4-1/2 months through January 7, 2013, and displaced 131 parking spaces during construction.

Phase 1B began Monday, October 22, and ran concurrently with the last portion of Phase 1A. Phase 1B prepared the site, utilities and a retaining wall for construction of the P&R garage and displaced an additional 89 parking spaces. Together, Phases 1A and 1B displaced 220 parking spaces at South Kirkland P&R from October 22 to January 7.

First Quarter 2013 Construction Look Ahead:

The second phase of the project began January 8, 2013, to construct the eastern part of the new transit loop roadway (Phase 2A) and the 532-stall P&R garage (Phase 2B). Phase 2B construction displaces 252 spaces at South Kirkland P&R, temporarily reducing to 344 the number of available parking spaces. The 108th Ave NE entrance to the P&R closed, a second NE 38th Pl entrance was added, and a new temporary sheltered bus stop opened on the completed western portion of the loop roadway. The permanent roadway and the new traffic signal should be completed at the end of March. Work on the new P&R garage will last 5-7 months and is scheduled to open summer 2013. Following the opening of the P&R garage, Phase 2C will re-stripe the west surface parking area.

Replacement parking during construction

Replacement parking is available 1.6 miles north of the South Kirkland P&R on part of the Northwest University campus at 6710 108th Ave NE. Northwest University 6710 Building P&R (temporary leased lot #671) has 61 P&R spaces, is available weekdays from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. and is served by Route 255.

Transit customers are also directed to Houghton P&R at 7024 116th Avenue NE. Located east of I-405 at NE 70th Place, Houghton has 470 parking spaces, and ample parking is available. Houghton P&R is well-served by Route 265 to downtown Seattle and First Hill, Route 277 to the U-District, and several eastside routes. Four weekday Route 265 trips (two westbound in the morning and two eastbound in the afternoon) were added from Houghton as of October 1 with the Fall service change. Costs for the added bus service are paid by developer Polygon NW/Kirkland P&R LLC.

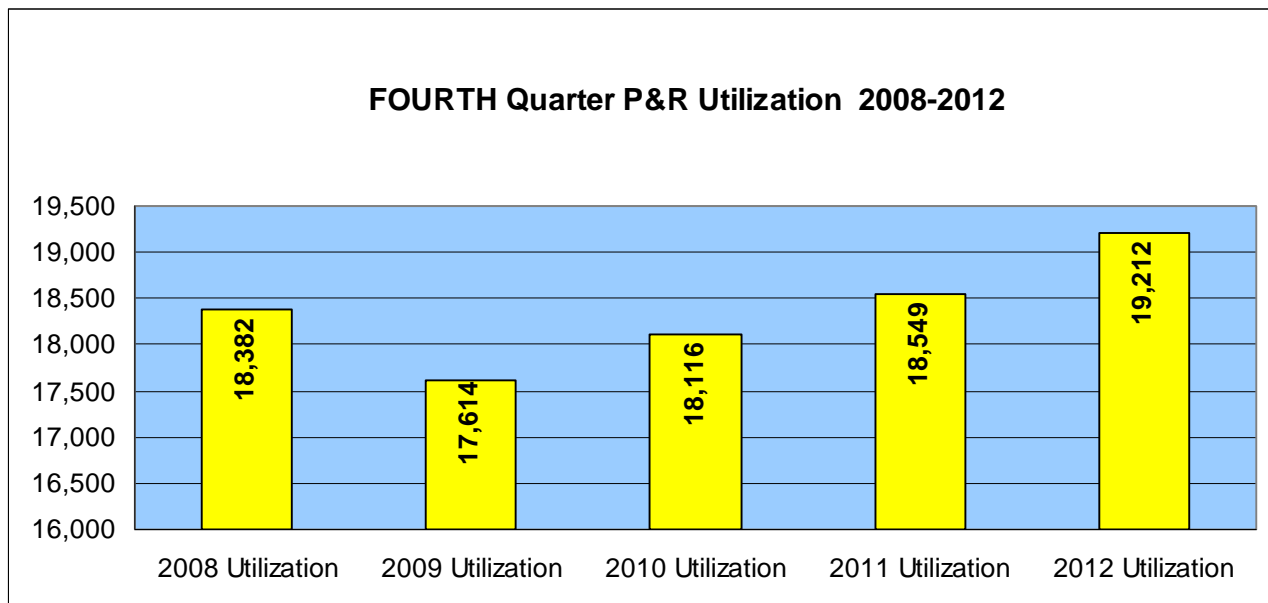
First Quarter 2013 Look Ahead:

Auburn P&R – A portion of Auburn P&R is being surplussed by King County, with the sale expected to close January 24, 2013. The City of Auburn purchased the parcel for airport-related uses and will transfer ownership via agreement to Orion Industries, a workforce development company and supplier to Boeing. Orion will build a manufacturing facility on the grassy northwest portion of the property. The sale includes an area of 114 parking spaces in the western part of the P&R lot, and thus Auburn P&R will downsize from 358 to 244 parking spaces when construction fencing goes up by February 10th. Metro will retain an access easement for vehicle circulation between the two sections of the sold parcel.

Monthly park-and-ride vehicle counts are taken by Metro Service Quality supervisors and Sound Transit security staff. These monthly counts are averaged to show quarterly utilization. Trends in P&R use are monitored and used when planning for new lots and changes in transit service.

PERMANENT PARK-AND-RIDE LOTS

During fourth quarter 2012, 17,678 (78 percent) of the 22,554 available permanent P&R spaces were used on an average daily basis. Although net parking capacity was 101

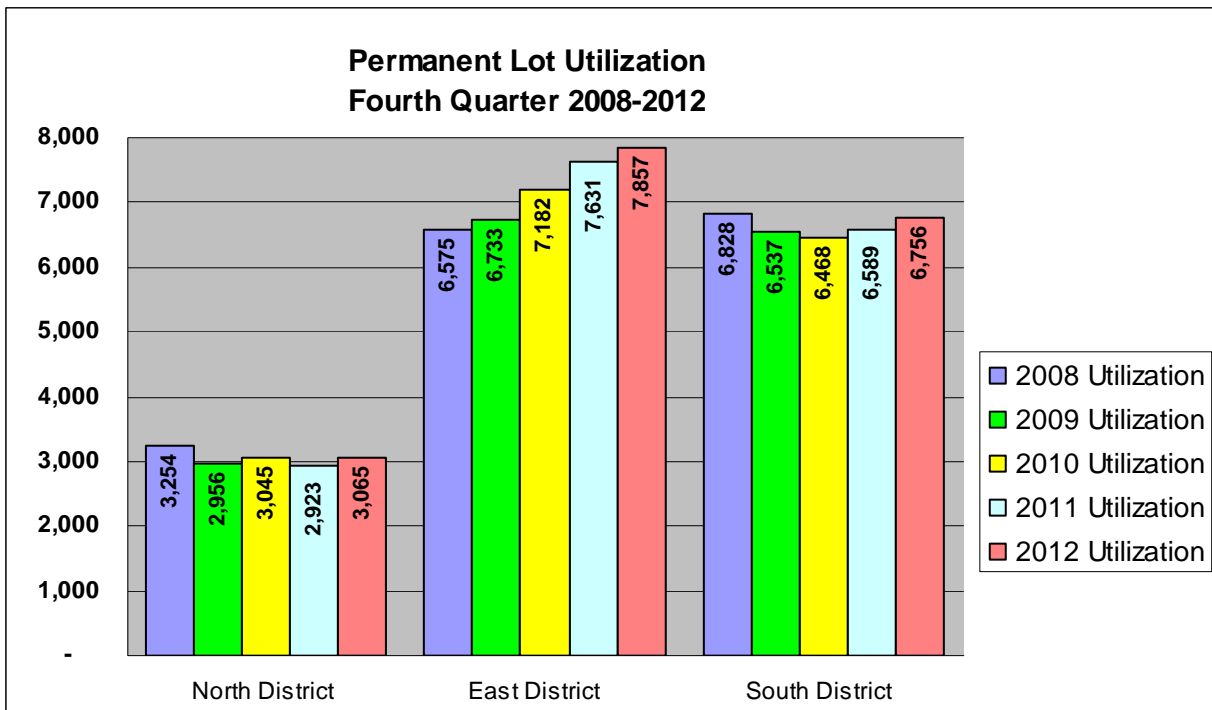
spaces (two percent) less than fourth quarter 2011, 535 more vehicles (three percent more) used the permanent P&Rs. The North District gained 142 vehicles per day, the East District added 226 vehicles per day, and the South District increased by 167 vehicles per day over fourth quarter 2011. The end of Aurora Corridor construction in the second quarter contributed to Shoreline P&R's average daily increase of 74 vehicles in the North District. In the East District, an average daily increase of 208 vehicles at Eastgate P&R garage and sizable increases at seven other eastside P&Rs were only partially offset by 196 fewer vehicles at a temporarily downsized South Kirkland P&R under construction. The South District benefited from the Burien TC garage that entered its second year of operation, with average daily use up 180 vehicles over fourth quarter 2011.

A. Park-and-Ride Changes

The number of parking spaces at South Kirkland P&R lot #728 was reduced by another 89 spaces on October 22, from 465 to 376 spaces, as construction began on Phase 1B of the TOD Project.

C. High-Utilization Permanent Lots

LEASED PARK-AND-RIDE LOTS

Sixty-six P&R's leased from, or donated by, private-property owners provided 2,589 parking spaces (10 percent) of total P&R capacity for commuters. Net leased parking capacity was 134 spaces greater than fourth quarter 2011, and leased lot use averaged 128 (nine percent) more vehicles. North District use decreased by 19 vehicles per day, the East District increased by 60 vehicles per day, and, compared with fourth quarter 2011, the South District gained 87 daily vehicles on average. The demand for parking at Northwest University's 6710 Building P&R (added in third quarter 2012) as a result of construction at South Kirkland P&R contributed in part to the higher East District use. The South District's higher use resulted primarily from an average daily increase of 37 vehicles at the Renton City Municipal Garage as well as the opening of Maple Valley Town Square P&R in October 2012.

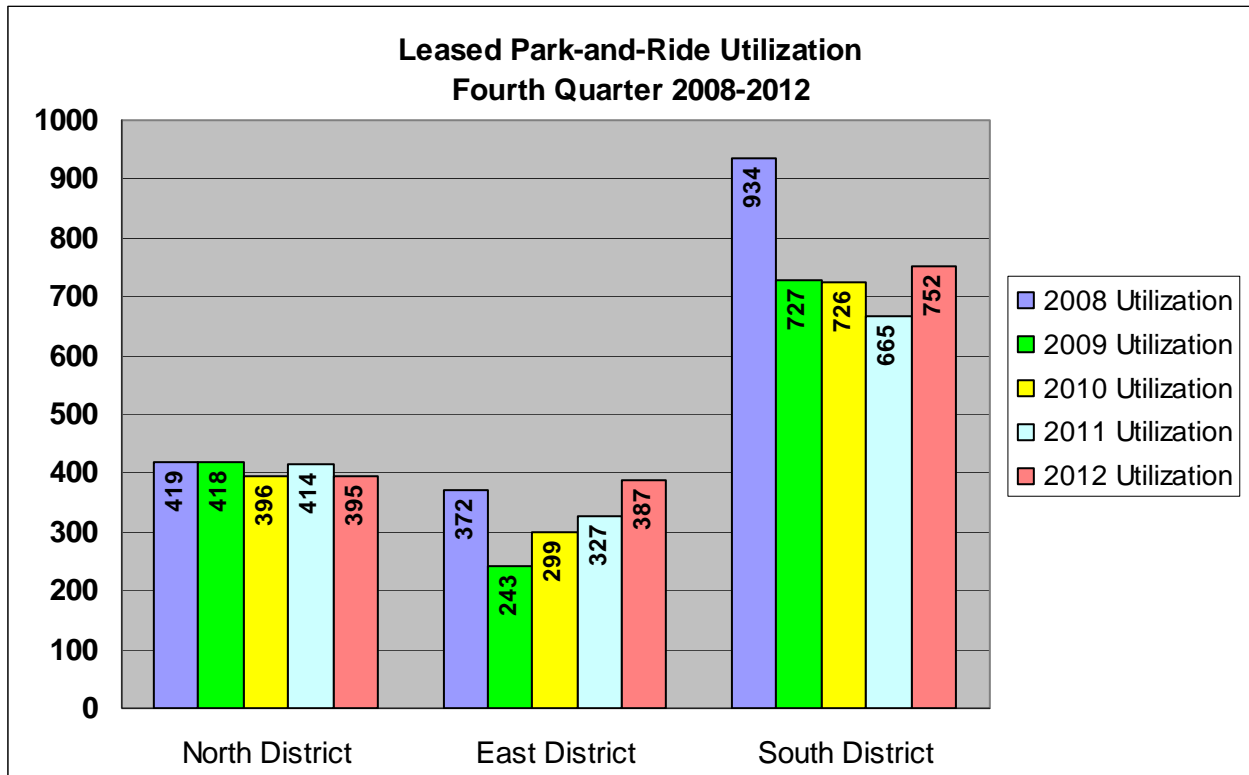
A. Park-and-Ride Changes

Maple Valley Town Square P&R (lot #652) opened October 1 at 26520 Maple Valley Highway, Maple Valley 98038. With 97 spaces available for public commuter parking, the P&R lot was built to provide public access to transit service and carpools as one of the permitting mitigation requirements for construction of the new Maple Valley Town Square retail development. The P&R is in the northeast corner of the retail center at 242nd Avenue SE and SE 264th Street, adjacent to anchor tenant Fred Meyer.

With the opening of the larger Maple Valley Town Square P&R on October 1, the **Four Corners Shopping Center P&R** (lot #667) was no longer needed and closed September 30 at the end of the third quarter.
