JOB DESCRIPTION: This position will provide first line supervision and leadership to section employees on all aspects of service, repair and maintenance of signal, communications and SCADA elements. Supervise other personnel as assigned, develop and update inspections preventive and corrective maintenance programs, and develop and update Standard Operating Procedures, safety procedures and work rules. Serve as the point of contact for all signal, communications and SCADA elements within the Light Rail Section.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Maintain, update and manage signal, communication and SCADA inspection and maintenance programs; participate in accident investigation teams and recommend corrective actions as necessary; assign and verify inspections, service and repairs; schedule work assignments for routine and special events; prioritize maintenance tasks; manage contract administration of maintenance and service providers; assist in the development and management of budget; oversee availability of supplies necessary to perform routine and special tasks; and administer personnel and discipline matters.

Coordinate the work of contractors; work closely with peers, management, and contractors to assure a safe, reliable and efficient Light Rail operation; assist with training and certification activities; prepare correspondence, reports, procedures, and maintains records; may represent light rail at disciplinary hearings; operate company assigned vehicles including hy-rail and aerial lift equipment; work in high places from mechanical lifts and structures to perform inspections; work indoors and outdoors and in inclement weather; properly enter and maintain safe area in confined spaces; and consult with engineering, warranty, safety, environmental, materials, transportation, and other staff in the development of maintenance programs and standard operating procedures.
