Introductory Statement

Provider staff working with individuals who have Behavioral Health challenges often need ready access to materials that can assist them in the care of others and help inform their work. Both academic resources and guidelines as well as quick reference materials are helpful when determining next steps, making treatment decisions or developing care plans. The Behavioral Health and Recovery Division (BHRD) encourages the use of this document to assist provider staff in their day-to-day activities.

This document serves as a collection of guidelines, articles, and practical tools/resources that can be used to inform services for individuals with Behavioral Health needs.

Domains reflect scopes of work provided by BHRD agencies, specific populations, and DSM-V diagnostic categories. Each domain contains two subcategories: “Guidelines/Articles” and “Practical Tools and Resources”. The domains are not intended to reflect every scope of work, every resource, or every unique individual that agency staff may encounter - but serve as helpful tools to assist staff. An Appendix, “Roadmap to Mental Health: Navigating the System in Puget Sound”, published by NAMI Seattle, is also included. This document includes multiple local resources that may be useful for addressing issues that span multiple domains.
