6. Director's Report

Dr. David Fleming, Director of the Department of Public Health, reported that PetSmart adopted language written by the Board of Health to label the pet food sold in its stores. PetSmart plans to implement this in all its stores nationwide.

Dr. Fleming presented results from a recent Seattle Children's Hospital menu labeling study. At the time that menu labeling took affect in King County, 60% of restaurants had "super sized" menu choices . The study found that a year and a half after menu labeling was implemented only 20% of restaurants offered "super sized" menu choices.

Dr. Fleming also reported that Navos recently opened a new Mental Health and Wellness Center in Burien. This was made possible by a grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.

Lastly, Dr. Fleming briefed the Board on the status of a project involving failing septic systems on Vashon Island. The failing systems were contributing to pollution in the Puget Sound and affecting the shellfish harvest. At the beginning of the project the Department of Public Health had 263 homes that required reevaluation of their septic systems. They are down to seven homes left. Dr. Fleming thanked the Vashon Maury Island Community Council for their collaboration.
