5 RULES AND REGULATIONS NO. 05-02

6  
7 An amendment for the protection of the public health against illness from hazardous  
8 waste; revising Rules and Regulations No. 66, as amended, and Chapter 2.08 of the  
9 Code of the King County Board of Health, enacted pursuant to RCW 70.05.060 and  
10 RCW 70.105.220 including the latest amendments or revisions thereto.

11  
12 BE IT ADOPTED BY THE KING COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH:

13  
14 **SECTION 1.** Section 2.08.090 of the Code of the King County Board of Health is hereby  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 **2.08.090 Fees.** The following fees are established to provide funds for contracts authorized by  
17 Section 2.08.085(B):

18 A. Each private and public entity which bills for solid waste collection services shall pay an  
19 amount equivalent to ~~sixty cents (\$0.60)~~ eighty cents (\$0.80) per month for each residential customer in  
20 King County, and ~~six dollars and seventy-seven cents (\$6.77)~~ nine dollars and seven cents (\$9.07) per  
21 month for each customer in King County which is not a residential customer. Billings from the  
22 department to each entity as above shall be based on actual customer data from the preceding calendar  
23 year.

24 B. Each operator of a sewage treatment plant serving more than fifty (50) customers shall  
25 pay an amount equivalent to ~~twenty-five dollars and thirty-one cents (\$25.31)~~ thirty-two dollars and forty  
26 cents (\$32.40) per million (1,000,000) gallons of sewage treated. Billings from the department to each  
27 operator as above shall be based on actual performance data from the preceding calendar year.

28 C. Each transfer station and landfill shall pay ~~one dollar (\$1.00)~~ one dollar and thirty-four  
29 cents (\$1.34) for each passenger licensed vehicle load of solid waste brought to such transfer station or  
30 landfill.

1 D. Each transfer station and landfill shall pay ~~two dollars and sixty-one cents (\$2.61)~~ three  
2 dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) per ton for each load of solid waste brought to such transfer station or  
3 landfill by a self hauler.

4 Billings from the Department to each transfer station and landfill operator as above shall be  
5 based on actual performance data from the preceding calendar quarter.

6 All fees shall be billed and remitted to the department on a quarterly basis. All payments shall be  
7 due forty-five (45) days after receipt of bill.

8 **SECTION 2.** Section 2.08.090 of the Code of the King County Board of Health is hereby  
9 amended to read as follows:

10 **2.08.090 Fees.** The following fees are established to provide funds for contracts authorized by  
11 Section 2.08.085(B):

12 A. Each private and public entity which bills for solid waste collection services shall pay an  
13 amount equivalent to eighty cents (\$0.80) per month for each residential customer in King County, and  
14 nine dollars and seven cents (\$9.07) per month for each customer in King County which is not a  
15 residential customer. Billings from the department to each entity as above shall be based on actual  
16 customer data from the preceding calendar year.

17 B. Each operator of a sewage treatment plant serving more than fifty (50) customers shall  
18 pay an amount equivalent to ~~thirty-two dollars and forty cents (\$32.40)~~ thirty-three dollars and ninety-  
19 two cents (\$33.92) per million (1,000,000) gallons of sewage treated. Billings from the department to  
20 each operator as above shall be based on actual performance data from the preceding calendar year.

21 C. Each transfer station and landfill shall pay one dollar and thirty-four cents (\$1.34) for  
22 each passenger licensed vehicle load of solid waste brought to such transfer station or landfill.

23 D. Each transfer station and landfill shall pay three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) per ton for

1 each load of solid waste brought to such transfer station or landfill by a self hauler.

2 Billings from the Department to each transfer station and landfill operator as above shall be  
3 based on actual performance data from the preceding calendar quarter.

4 All fees shall be billed and remitted to the department on a quarterly basis. All payments shall be  
5 due forty-five (45) days after receipt of bill.

6 **SECTION 3. Effective Date of Section 1.** Section 1 of this rule and regulation shall take  
7 effect on January 1, 2006.


8 **SECTION 4. Effective Date of Section 2.** Section 2 of this rule and regulation shall take
