

# Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening



Providing breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services to eligible Washington residents

Learn about options for getting screened!

**The Breast, Cervical and Colon Health Program provides free cancer screening for eligible WA residents.**

This program serves people who:

- Don't have health insurance or have a high deductible.
- Have low income.
- Meet the age guidelines.

#### Services include:

- Breast cancer screenings (breast exams and mammograms).
- Cervical cancer screenings (Pap and HPV tests).
- Follow-up tests as needed, based on screening results.
- Assistance with navigating resources for treatment if needed.

#### Cancer screening saves lives!

- As you get older, you are at **higher risk** of getting cancer.
- If cancer is found early, it is often **easier to treat** and treatment is more successful.
- The best way to find cancer early is through **routine screening**. There are often no warning signs.

If you aren't eligible for Washington Apple Health and don't have insurance, you may still be eligible for free cancer screenings.
