


## **Seattle and King County Monthly Syphilis Report: June 2022**




MSM = men who have sex with men MSW = men who have sex with women only

## Pregnant and congenital syphilis cases, King County July 2020-June 2022



So far in 2022, 19 syphilis cases were pregnant at the time of diagnosis and 6 congenital cases have been diagnosed.
