1.	 Continue active daily surveillance for influenza-like illness Screen residents, staff, and visitors for influenza-like illness throughout flu season 				
2.	Continue environmental cleaning of high touch areas				
3.	Check stock of influenza test kits. Re-order as needed				
4.	Encourage continued respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene				
	 Maintain hand hygiene station supply of tissues, alcohol based hand sanitizer, and face masks 				
5.	Resume group activities, parties, and events. Re-open common dining room				
6.	Resume unrestricted admissions of new or returning residents				
7.	Remove outbreak notices from entrances to facility				
8.	Conduct post-outbreak debrief/review
