# Community Agreements

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1. **Together we know a lot;** alone we don't know it all
2. **Center People of Color:** We deliberately take action to acknowledge and center people of color, and the diversity that exist within the spectrum of our present-day work, and we give reverence to that strength, resilience, and talent without appropriation.
3. **Make space, take space.** Practice equity by sharing the floor.
4. **Liberation as a Focus:** We aim to create a space where people can show up fully in who they are, how they are. We commit to healing, self-awareness, and service to each other.

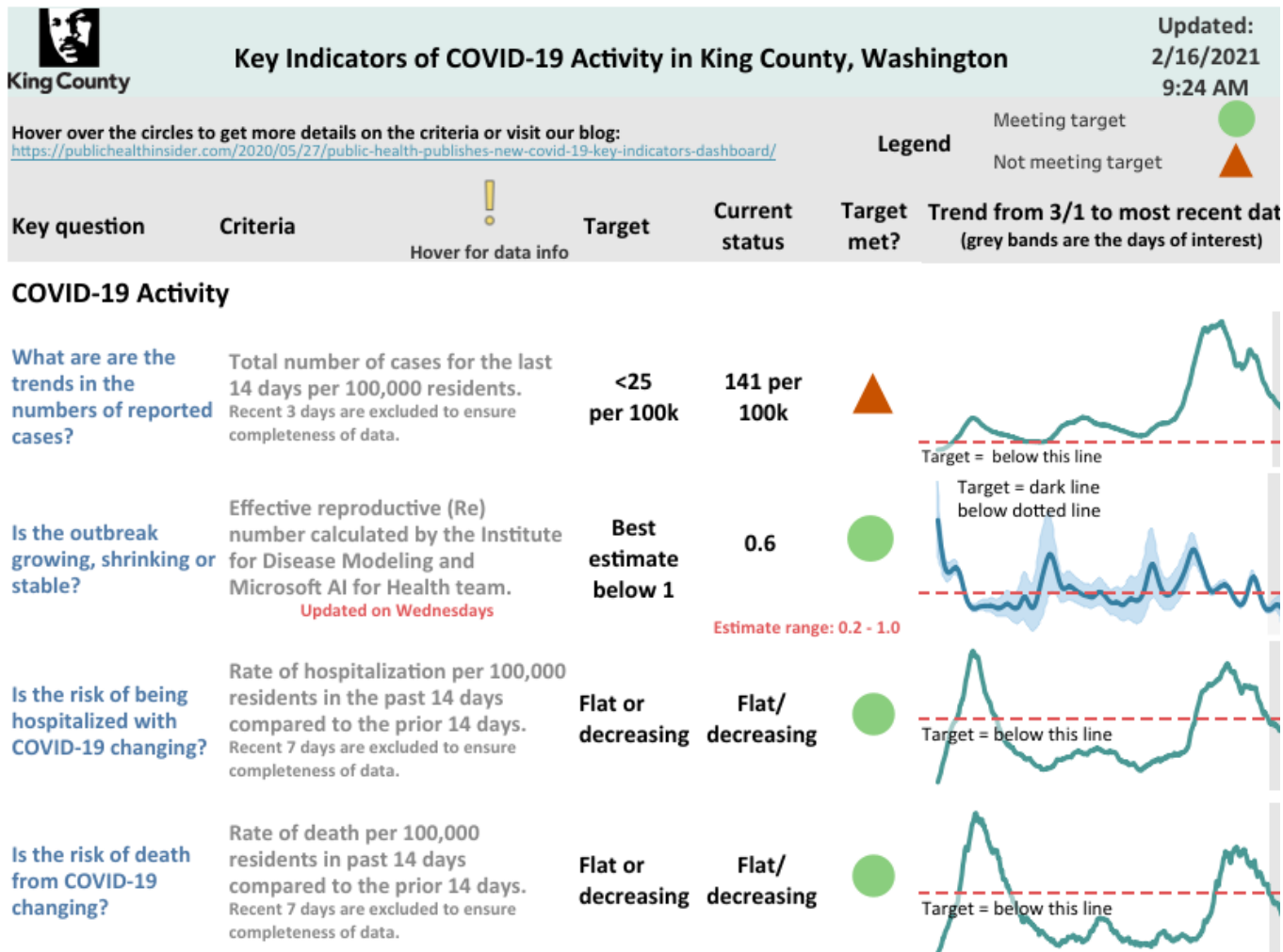
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**5. De-Center Whiteness:** We openly acknowledge the history of oppression in the U.S, and consciously prioritize the leadership of Black, Indigenous, and People of Color, queer and trans people, people with different body sizes, and people living with disabilities.

**6. Lean into discomfort,** it's how we grow.

**7. Multiple Truths:** We acknowledge that there are multiple and concurrent truths everywhere, all the time. Using the “both/and” framework, we recognize that all truths can exist, support, and conflict with each other in the same space.
