Domestic violence (DV) patterns need monitoring: available data is limited



Emergency department visits related to DV have declined, as did all emergency department (ED) visits

Since June, the rate of DV-related ED visits is comparable 2019 rates



DV-related emergency department visits in 2020 were higher among

Hispanic vs. non-Hispanic

American Indian/Alaskan Native and Black/African American vs. white race groups

Other demographics were similar in 2019 and 2020

DV-related deaths are up in 2020



National Domestic Violence Hotline Calls among King County residents




April, May, and July had the highest monthly call volumes

filings has been increasing since April 2020 and are now back to 2019 levels


