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1. You are fully vaccinated **two weeks after your final dose**. Drink lots of water, stay warm, and rest.
2. Some people might have a sore arm, a headache, feel tired, or have a fever for a day or two.
3. If your symptoms don't go away after a few days, or if you have other questions, call **425-899-3000**, then **press 2**. Language/ASL help is available.
4. You can take an over-the-counter pain medicine like ibuprofen or aspirin, unless you were told not to.

6. Please continue to **wear a mask, stay six feet from others, and wash your hands often.**
