Can I get vaccinated if I'm pregnant, breastfeeding, or thinking about getting pregnant?

Yes. The vaccine is safe and effective, and there are no known fertility concerns for you or your partner.

Will it protect my baby?

You may pass on protection to your baby if you get vaccinated while pregnant or breastfeeding.

Talking with a health care provider before getting vaccinated can help to answer any questions. But this is not required if you are ready to get a vaccine.
