CONSTRUCTION REPORT FOR WATER SYSTEM PROJECTS (To be submitted in Triplicate)

Effective July 1, 1994, the following regulations apply: WAC 246-291 and King County Board of Health Title 12. A construction report and as-built drawing shall be submitted to and accepted by the Health Officer within 60 days of completion and prior to use of any project for which plans and specifications have been approved by the Health Officer for projects designed by a professional engineer/designer. The construction report must be signed by a professional engineer/designer. The report shall state in the opinion of the signee whether the installation, testing and disinfection of the system were carried out in accordance with WAC 246-291 and Title 12. The construction report is to be submitted in conjunction with an as-built drawing of the completed system (in triplicate), along with the final system inspection fee.

- If a project is being completed in staged construction, attach a map and description of project a.
- As future portions of staged construction projects are completed, each must be certified as required by WAC 246.291 and King County Board of Health Title 12, Chapter 12.20.010(E). b.
