HELPFUL TIPS

YOUR HOME

- Inspect your septic system as needed or every 1 to 3 years based on system type.
- ▶ Have your septic tank pumped by a certified pumper as needed.
- ▶ Keep septic tank lids accessible and secured.
- Conserve water.
- Quickly repair leaky faucets and toilets.
- Spread out when you do laundry; wash full loads, restrict to 2-3 loads per day.
- Avoid using a garbage disposal.
- Avoid overloading the drain by running the dishwasher & washing machine at different times.


▶ Be aware of what you flush:



- Only put toilet paper, poop, and pee down the drain.
- Keep food scraps out of your drain.
- Pour oil and grease from your pans into a can and throw into trash instead of pouring down the drain.
- Use eco friendly, fragrance free cleaning products & avoid toxic chemicals.

YOUR DRAINFIELD

- ▶ Direct water from downspouts and roofs away from the drainfield.
- Only grow shallow root plants over your drainfield. Keep trees away.
- Protect your drainfield from parked vehicles that can damage it.
