## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:**

The proposed project consists of Green Section (GS) 30, LLC, of 2319 Hobart Avenue SW Seattle, WA 98116 establishing an inert waste material landfill within the City of Enumclaw to accept only inert waste materials.

The proposed inert waste material landfill site is located at 36000 Enumclaw – Franklin Road, Enumclaw WA 99022 on a 129.5 acres of permitted Surface Mine Reclamation site Permit #70-012688. The parcel is a portion of Section 30, Township 21 North, Range 07 East, Willamette Meridian, King County. The inert waste landfill will be accepting following materials:

- Cured concrete that has been used for structural and construction purposes, including embedded steel reinforcing and wood that was produced from mixtures of Portland cement and sand, gravel or other similar materials.
- Asphaltic materials that have been used for structural and construction purposes (e.g., roads, dikes, paving) that were produced from mixtures of petroleum asphalt and sand, gravel or other similar materials.
- Brick and masonry that have been used for structural and construction purposes.
- Ceramic materials produced from fired clay or porcelain.
- Glass, composed primarily of sodium, calcium, silica, boric oxide, magnesium oxide, lithium oxide or aluminum oxide. Glass presumed to be inert includes, but not limited to, window glass, glass containers, glass fiber, and glasses resistant to thermal shock.

This inert waste materials landfill will be regulated under an inert waste material landfill permit issued by Seattle – King County Department of Public Health. The permit will be issued pursuant to Chapter 173-350-410 WAC and King County Board of Health Code Title 10 (Solid Waste). This permit allows accepting and depositing of inert waste materials in the cavity generated by the Surface Mine Reclamation process.
