Auto-Renewal Rates & Retro

Percentage of Apple Health recipients whose coverage was auto-renewed:

| Renewal month | Percentage |
|--|------------|
| April 2018 (used to be due for renewal 4/30/18) | 76% |
| March 2018 (used to be due for renewal 3/31/18) | 75% |
| February 2018 (used to be due for renewal 2/28/18) | 75% |

Retro status:

| Oldest received date | Cases waiting to be worked |
|----------------------|----------------------------|
| February 23, 2018 | 1217 |

COFA updates

- Individuals from Compact of Free Association (COFA) islands (Palau, Marshall Islands, Micronesia) are not eligible for federal Apple Health, but Washington state does cover children under age 19 and pregnant adults; DSHS offers Medical Care Services (MCS). Eligible for AEM.
- Starting in 2019, HCA will cover the cost of premiums and cost-sharing of a silver level qualified health plan
- STATUS: Outreach beginning September 2018. HCA has a list of participants for the advisory council for a meeting and is in the planning stages.

Former foster care medical program (D26)

- Provides continued Apple Health coverage for youth who were in foster care on their 18th birthday
- No income limit, but must be a Washington state resident and meet citizenship or immigration requirements
- Youth on foster care medical (D02) AND in foster care on their 18th birthday automatically transfer to D26

Former foster care medical program (D26)

- Automatically enrolled in Coordinated Care (except for tribal members), but they may request disenrollment at anytime
- Youth in foster care in another state at the age of 18 are not eligible for this program, but should apply for other coverage through Healthplanfinder
