Minimum Wage Increase

- Effective January 1 2019, Washington's minimum wage increase to \$12 except in areas where there continues to be a higher local minimum wage

Complete Eats

- Complete Eats will be available at all Safeway stores in Washington except stores located in Seattle 12/5/18-6/30/19.
- Safeway stores in Seattle have a similar program funded through the Sweetened Beverage Tax.

Complete Eats

- Shoppers who buy at least \$10 worth of qualifying fruits and vegetables using their SNAP food benefits and their Safeway Club Card will get a coupon for \$5 off their next purchase.
- Shoppers can choose from fresh, canned and frozen fruits and vegetables, so long as the products have no added fats, sugars or salt.
- Look for the green Complete Eats logo on shelf tags for eligible canned and frozen products.

Sign-On Support (SOS) Team

- Customers experiencing difficulties establishing the Client Benefit Account can receive assistance by:
 - Asking the Contact Center Call Navigator or Financial Worker to make a referral to the Sign-on Support (SOS) Team
 - Worker will make three attempts to call back
 - Worker will leave a message for client
