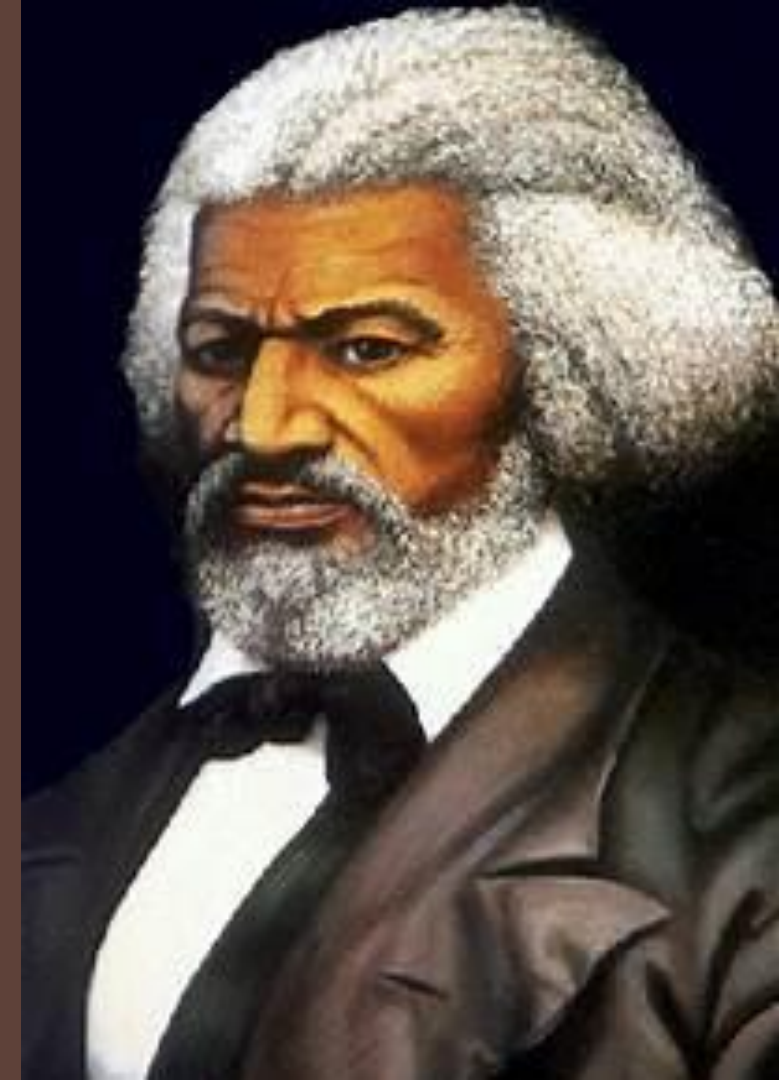

SPECIAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD (SEP)

Changes in household size (i.e.): Marriage, registered domestic partnership, adoption.	Losing a dependent or dependent status. For current customer only.
Filed or reconciled taxes.	Change in program eligibility or amount of financial help: A change in income or number of household members on the application cause your program eligibility to change.
Loss of other minimum essential coverage	Permanent move
Change in citizenship or lawful presence status	Release from jail/prison

ALIEN EMERGENCY MEDICAL (AEM)

Alien Medical Programs (commonly referred to as AEM) available to Washington State residents who are "Qualified Aliens" who have not met their 5-year bar, "Nonqualified Aliens", or undocumented individuals. (hca.wa.gov)

How to qualify:

Individual must have or need at least one of the following:

- A qualifying emergent medical condition such as emergency room care, inpatient admission, or outpatient surgery;
- A cancer treatment plan;
- Dialysis treatment;
- Antirejection medication for a post organ transplant; or on long-term care services (LTC)

How to apply:

HOSPITAL CHARITY CARE

- Federal & state laws require hospitals to provide care for free or at a lower cost if a person cannot afford to pay for the medical treatment.
- Charity Care covers “medically necessary” treatment. This includes inpatient hospital stays and emergency room visits.

Hospitals are now required to do the following:

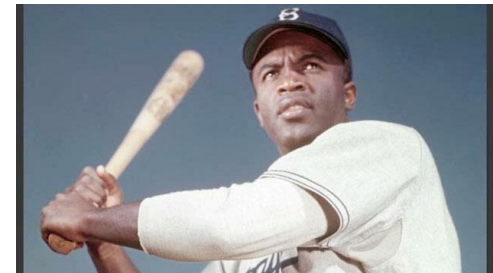
- Post a notice about Charity Care in the emergency room, admissions area, and the financial service or billing areas that are open to patients
- Provide a patient with Charity Care information at intake or discharge
- Post a plain language summary of the hospital’s current Charity Care policy and the application form on the hospital’s website
- Provide the summary and application in all languages spoken by more than 10% of the population served by the hospital
- Provide a patient with Charity Care information in every billing statement
- Provide all billing statements and written communications in both English and the second most spoken language in the hospital’s service area

BREAST CERVICAL COLON HEALTH CARE PROGRAM

- Breast screening for ages 40-64
- Screening services are available to the transgender community
- The program may provide services **for women under 40 if have increased risk for cancer**
- Client will get a Clinical Breast Examination (CBE)
- Please call 1-800-756-5437 for an appointment
- Colon Program is a colon screening program. Clients will receive a Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT)
- Colonoscopy is provider by recommendation of the provider
- Colon screening for ages 50-64
- Screening services are available to the transgender community

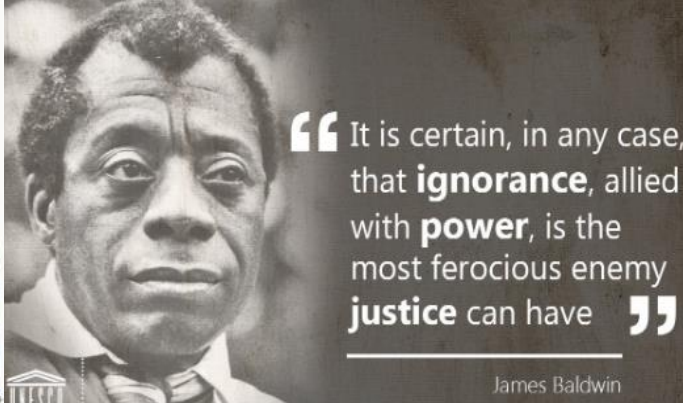
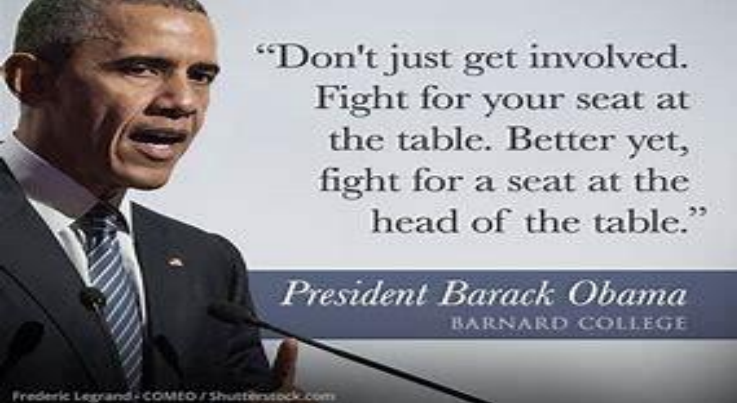
