UPDATE ON TRANSIT FARE SUSPENSION:

- Metro will not be collecting fares for the month of September. All other transit agencies – Sound Transit, Pierce, Community Transit and Everett Transit have resumed fare collection.
- Masks are required
- Buses are not operating at full capacity to allow for proper social distancing

PEOPLE CAN STILL ENROLL IN ORCA LIFT

- People can call our Community Health Access Program: 1-800-756-5437 and enroll over the phone and the card will be mailed out. *Please note that cards being issued come pre-loaded with \$10.00

SUBSIDIZED ANNUAL PASS (ORCA LIFT)

- The subsidized annual pass program will launch October. The new program will provide a fully subsidized pass on ORCA LIFT or a RRFP card (regional reduced fare pass) The pass will be valid for 12 months on Metro and Sound Transit.
- Eligibility for the program is based off enrollment in one of the following DSHS Benefit Programs:
 - Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) / State Family Assistance (SFA)
 - Pregnant Women Assistance (PWA)
 - Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Aged, Blind, or Disabled (ABD)
 - Housing & Essential Needs (HEN)

SUBSIDIZED ANNUAL PASS (ORCA LIFT)

- Clients who are eligible for the program will be able to enroll over the phone by calling CHAP (1-800-756-5437), or the DSHS customer service #. The card will be mailed to the client.
- In person enrollment locations will include the ORCA LIFT Office, Federal Way Storefront, and Catholic Community Services Randolph Carter Center.
