

What we're doing

- Producing videos in Marshallese
- In-Person events (Small number of events are inside, however majority are outside. All outside events in tents with heating)
- Pacific Islander Health Board is doing work specific to 98023 (Federal Way)
- Some areas don't have a natural place for outreach or they lack any places for outgoing outreach. This includes Burien, Redmond, SeaTac and Kent. We're working with the small community newspaper.
- Piloting an event in DesMoines at the North Hill Espresso. This includes providing "cup sleeves" for the stand to give-up. Stand is providing sack lunches to children & we're covering the cost of drinks for customers from 11:00-3:00. The team will be outside and we have one health plan attending. If successful we'll expand in January.
