Public health emergency

- The Public Health Emergency (PHE) was renewed and extended through July 19, 2021.
- According to the <u>HHS letter to Governors</u>*, the PHE could be extended through the rest of 2021.
- ▶ HCA and its partners continue to maintain coverage for Apple Health clients by extending Apple Health benefits during the PHE. HCA will continue to share updates as new information becomes available.

Public charge

<u>Public charge</u>* has ended for most Apple Health (Medicaid) coverage

The 2019 public charge rule from the previous administration has ended. U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will no longer consider receiving Apple Health coverage for most individuals a negative factor when a person is applying for permeant residency.

Postpartum coverage

State Senate Bill 5068* passed and was signed by Governor Inslee.

This bill directs HCA to extend postpartum coverage to all women from 60 days to 12 months.
