King County Metro On-Demand Flexible Services Quick Guide

King County Metro's on-demand service is transportation when and where you need it. We provide riders with flexible, convenient alternatives to traditional transit. Whether bus stops are far away or an additional transit trip is difficult, Community Ride, Via to Transit, and Ride Pingo to Transit are there to help.

Request a ride easily using the app or by phone, and we'll pick you up and drop you off anywhere within the service area. Some services connect riders with transit or community hubs, and others drop riders off at any destination, as long as it sits within the service area. The ride may also be shared with other passengers who are traveling in the same direction.

How to ride:

- 1. **Book a ride on-demand** with the app or by calling the phone number. Expect to be picked up within 5-45 minutes of your trip request; pick-up location may require a short walk.
- 2. Pay upon boarding standard Metro bus fares and transfer rules apply. Rides may be shared with other Metro customers.
- 3. Arrive at your destination: Service is available for trips in the defined service areas only. Wheelchair accessible vehicles and bike racks are available.
