OE IX Talking Points

- Tens of thousands of Washingtonians who buy their coverage directly from a health insurance company can save hundreds of dollars per month, but only if they sign up through *Washington Healthplanfinder*.
- Off-exchange consumers –earning less than about \$50,000 could save up to \$525 per month if they switch to Washington Healthplanfinder.
- Families earning well above \$100,000 –who were not previously eligible for federal help now qualify for tax credits worth hundreds of dollars per household per month.
- Most off-Exchange consumers will be able to save hundreds of dollars each month when they switch to a plan that is identical to the one they have now, and they can carry over any spending on their deductible to their new plan.



Don't forget Cascade Plans

Cascade plans are a type of Qualified Health Plan offered by insurance carriers on the Exchange. These plans have a standard cost-sharing design at each metal level, meaning they have the same deductible, copays, and co-insurance for medical services. The plans offer the same services before the deductible, no matter which carrier is offering it.


Federal Way Exchange Storefront Open for Walk-in's

Additional Resources-Seattle Relief Fund

- The Seattle Relief Fund is **providing** direct cash assistance to Seattle's most vulnerable low-income residents and their households who have been impacted by the COVID-19 crisis.
- Live within the City of Seattle (proof is required) .
- Over the age of 18.
- Have children attending Seattle Public Schools .
- Or receiving the City of Seattle Promise program
- Be an artist/cultural worker who has owned or rented an art studio or rehearsal space within the boundaries of the City of Seattle at any time since March 2020.
- Meet income guidelines.
- **Immigration is not a factor. But if they received the City of Seattle COVID relief fund previously they are not eligible.**
- **You do need to be positive for COVID just impacted by COVID.**



Seattle Relief Fund continues.....

- Apply online ([Seattlerelief.com](https://seattlerelief.com)) or through a community organization.
- Applications will be accepted for 3 weeks from October 25-November 16.
- Awards will be \$1,000-\$3,000 depending on Family Size
- Decisions will be made from November 29, 2021 to December 6, 2021 and payments will be sent after **December 9, 2021.**
- **Checks are sent directly to the person.**
