

2019 HHOT RFA Results

Background

- \$826,000 VSHSL funding - Healthy Living Strategy 2B
- RFA released 1/31/19, due 3/15/19
- Eligible sites: permanent supportive housing, permanent housing with support services, or bridge/transitional housing buildings/sites in King County

Governance Council Priorities

- 30% of available funding to agencies who plan to operate HHOT outside of the City of Seattle
- High levels of tenants with chronic health or disabling conditions that are not otherwise receiving needed health supports

Applicants and Awards

- Neighborcare received award for full amount requested (\$293,291) to serve Aurora House and Clement Place (both DESC) located north Seattle
- Harborview received a reduced award of \$532,709 (less than full request) to serve Union Hotel (DESC), Lyon Building (DESC), and Compass Men's Program, all in downtown/Pioneer Square
