New Strategy



\$150,000

To an organization that is led by People of Color with a focus on serving African Americans or Native Americans.*

- *- A majority (50% +) of people of color in leadership, board, staff and individuals served
- An expressed and demonstrated commitment to racial equity and communities of color as reflected in its mission & program strategy

Applicants can propose to provide **Medical** care, **Behavioral Health** care, or **Enabling** services for individuals experiencing homelessness. Enabling services include case management, referrals, translation/interpretation, transportation, eligibility assistance, health education, environmental health risk reduction, health literacy, and outreach.

Technical assistance will be available to smaller organizations during the RFP application process. To qualify for technical assistance, organizations must **1)** have fewer than 20 full-time equivalents and **2)** an operating budget of **less than \$4 million** in the prior fiscal year. HCHN will provide support to the selected agency on administrative and reporting requirements for the first year of their award.
