

UDS report submission & financial measures - Governance Council update

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6/1/2021

The Uniform Data System (UDS) report is submitted annually to our Federal grantor, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). The UDS report combines all our patient and visit information with our financial information for each calendar year. This is an update on the financial measures we reported for 2020.

The UDS report is due each year on February 15th, covering the prior calendar year. Each health center then works with a HRSA contracted UDS reviewer to finalize the report, usually by mid-March. Our 2020 report was submitted 2/12/21 and accepted by the reviewer on 3/16/21. We did not meet our overall target of 95% of our HRSA patient target – we served 19,494 unduplicated patients in 2020, toward our patient target of 21,957, or 89%. Dropping below 95% of the patient target can result in funding reductions from HRSA, however, will not be applied for targets unmet in 2020 due to the pandemic impacting health center visits nationwide.

Prior year comparison reports show how our Health Center compares to State and national grantees in total, and with other homeless grantees. In general, as a public entity in an urban area with a high cost of living, we have higher costs per visit and per patient in comparison to other health centers. The table below shows these measures for 2019.
