CALL TO ORDER

1. Welcome & Introductions

Kristina Sawyckyj welcomed attendees, including members of the CAG, to the meeting of the HCHN Governance Council (GC). Full quorum present.

2. Minutes

GC members reviewed the minutes from the 10/18 meeting. Zsa Zsa Floyd made motion to approve the minutes, Jesus Rodriguez seconded; vote was unanimous in favor of the motion, with Leslie Enzian and Eleta Wright abstaining.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

REGULAR AGENDA AND BOARD PROCESS

1. Nominations for HCHN Officers

Patricia Dehart was nominated for Chair and Amanda Richer was nominated for Vice-Chair. The GC will vote on Chair and Vice-Chair at the December meeting.

2. Reschedule January/February GC Meetings (Holidays)

The GC came to consensus to reschedule the 2022 January and February meetings to Monday, January 10, 2022 and Monday, February 28, 2022. Rekha Ravindran will send updated meeting invites.

3. 330h Project Director Annual Review

Semone presented the 330h Project Director Annual Review. Jesus made motion to approve 330h Project Director Rekha Ravindran's performance evaluation, LaMont Green seconded; vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

- 4. HCHN Committee Updates and Actions
 - a. Community Advisory Group 12/1

Rekha revisited the CAG priorities for member discussion. Denise Hawthorne provided updates about the HCHN food card and incentive policies.

b. Executive Committee – 12/1

There were no new updates.

c. Program Evaluation Committee – 1/19

There were no new updates.

d. Racial Equity Workgroup - 12/13

Chante presented updated contract language for discussion and formal GC endorsement. PowerPoint is attached. Jesus made motion to formally endorse the contract language as presented, Zsa Zsa seconded; vote was unanimous in favor of the motion. Eleta added that the workgroup is developing a resource guide for contractors.

e. Behavioral Health Workgroup – 12/14

The workgroup discussed how to file grievances, the difficulty of finding treatment for needs separate from substance use disorders, and the barriers and delays in getting into behavioral health services for unhoused people.

5. HCHN Admin Update

a. HCHN RFPs/HRSA Funding

Semone said HCHN's negotiations with the Federal Way Black Collective continue. Best practices from the negotiating process are being documented and will be shared with the rest of Public Health.

b. COVID-19 Homelessness Response

Semone said the Public Health COVID field-based teams are working to standardize team communication and will host the second day of their retreat in December.

c. Staffing Update

Semone provided staffing and hiring updates and said that CHS Division Director TJ Cosgrove's last day is December 10, 2021, and the hiring process for a new director continues.

d. Other Updates

Semone said that the HCHN team is in discussions with NHCHC about the May 2022 conference in Seattle. He also said that HCHN Admin Team staff submitted an abstract for the conference.

He noted an overdose prevention workgroup has been proposed to understand resources and gaps.

Semone also shared that the City of Seattle, the Regional Housing Authority (RHA), HCHN, and other service providers met to discuss emergency response structures and the transition from the City of Seattle to the RHA.
