# What is a Single Audit & Why do we have one?

- As a government agency in the state of Washington, King County is audited by the State Auditors Office (SAO) on an annual basis
  - Staff from the SAO come on site and review documentation, transactions, policies and procedures, interview staff, etc
  - This audit covers ALL King County Federal Funds received

# What is a Single Audit & Why do we have one?

- Every year the SAO selects several Federal grants to reviewthey review activity/transactions from the previous year
  - 330h HCHN was selected this year!
    - AND We still need to be aware of any findings other grants receive because we will be selected in the futurethe SAO will heavily scrutinize any activities related to any previous findings
    - We do not want to be at risk for repeat findings

- We have been briefed that there were <u>no findings</u> for 330h!
  - We did receive a verbal recommendation 1 patient sampled in our EPIC reporting system had the incorrect sliding scale recorded
- Also no findings for the CRF (COVID Relief Funds) which partially funded our COVID Homeless response programs
