FENTANYL-LACED PILLS ARE FLOODING THE PNW

Your contacts may be the same, but the drug supply in Washington has changed. Between 2018 and 2020, **fentanyl-related overdose deaths increased 164% in King County alone**, and your friends may have no idea their stash is laced. Following these two steps might just save a life:

CARRY NALOXONE

- The only medication that can **reverse an opioid overdose**.
- **Available for free** in King County.
