Responsibilities include assisting in contact investigations to find active and latent cases of Tuberculosis (TB) infection among diverse populations of King County including the homeless. A primary responsibility of this position is to conduct field investigations for the purpose of locating and contacting potentially infected or exposed populations to TB. The DIS will conduct client interviews with TB cases, suspects and their contacts. The DIS will be responsible for making appropriate referrals for treatment, screening and other medically appropriate referrals including those for participation in TB research projects (TBTC). Duties include administering and interpreting TB skin tests, venipuncture, education, counseling and assistance with other TB program functions as requested. The DIS's duties will also include administering contact questionnaires, preparing and maintaining detailed case and contact records and conducting follow-up interviews. Work is conducted in the main clinic and satellite sites, in agencies serving homeless people, on th streets, at workplaces and other institutions. WORK ENVIRONMENT: Clinic and field. ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS Maintain confidentiality of all records data and information as required by section, department or state regulation. Interview and counsel clients who are at risk for or have TB infection and elicit the name of contacts. Conduct field investigations to locate and contact infected or potentially infected clients. Conduct follow-up and referrals to ensure examination and treatment compliance for TB and LTBI individuals.
