JOB DESCRIPTION: A paramedic trainee is a skilled paraprofessional who provides advanced life support to the sick and injured outside of a hospital setting and under the direction of a base hospital physician. Two paramedic trainees work as a team assigned to an emergency service vehicle under the direction of two Senior Paramedics, performing various roles. These include but are not limited to patient assessment, medication administration, airway management, intravenous access, development of a treatment plan, securing a medical history from family or bystanders.

WORK ENVIRONMENT: Field

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: Performs physically and emotionally demanding work on a regular and reliable basis. Accesses emergency scenes, and approaching on foot when necessary. Communicates with an emergency medical personnel, and a work partner. Unloads gurney, appropriate portable supplies and safety equipment and transports to the patient at the scene of an emergency. Provides emergency assessment and treatment for patients. Assists in extricating trapped victims or moving obstacles in order to obtain access to the patients. Communicates with patients and/or family regarding medical conditions and determines appropriate medical care facility as well as the transportation mode for patients. Transports patients to the emergency vehicle and delivers the patient to the appropriate medical facility. Accurately prepares forms, reports, paperwork and callbacks as required. Performs presentations to public agencies and schools. Regularly checks emergency service vehicle, supplies and tools using an established checklist and performs minor maintenance and updates records. Stocks supplies. Attends 50 hours of approved continuing education annually and special training provided by King County Medic One. Provides information to a court through deposition of testimony, or physical appearance.
