LOCAL SERVICES ACCESSIBILITY

Working to locate the Department of Local Services in or near the unincorporated communities they serve and invest in technology to improve local services.

AGRICULTURAL DRAINAGE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM & SURFACE WATER MANAGEMENT

Adds \$550K for the Agriculatural Drainage Assistance Program (ADAP), while requiring an ADAP sustainability plan and a report on accommodating property owners facing hardships in paying Surface Water Management fees.



SUBAREA PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH GRANTS

Increases biennial funding for Rural Behavioral Health Grants for communitybased organizations to \$710K.



Specifies requirements for an equity impact analysis and community center feasibility analysis in the Skyway/West Hill subarea plan and a community center feasibility analysis in the Snoqualmie Valley Northeast King County subarea plan.

Requires the economic development position in Local Services Administration to support work in rural and urban unincorporated areas.
