KEY POINTS

Participation in the Family Treatment Court (FTC) is completely voluntary.

In FTC, parents will be required to go to treatment and attend court regularly

At court, they will be encouraged to keep making positive progress and receive immediate feedback on their case.

Many services are available and include substance use treatment, counseling, parenting classes and support, housing resources, child-care assistance, and Wraparound coordination.

Each parent will receive a team of people who will monitor his/her case and work together to support recovery.

The FTC team includes: the parent’s attorney, Assistant Attorney General (AAG), DCYF social worker, a treatment advocate, peer mentor, CASA and/or the child’s attorney and judge.

King County FTC

If you are a parent involved in the dependency system due to drugs or alcohol, Family Treatment Court may be an option.
