Wade was codified into law• Impacts on BIPOC communities• Right to privacy, bodily autonomy and individual sovereignty compromised by language in ruling <p>Check-In with members and personal impact</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Responsibility of WAB to be heard• Trying not to get too narrowly focused on abortion because the attack on individual sovereignty and bodily autonomy will continue• Not be complacent about protected status in Washington State <p>King County’s response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sponsored ordinance to DPH – ½ to NWAAF and ½ to DPH• Perry, Kohl-Welles, Zahilay &?• Executive Constantine – KC Executive funds cannot be used to investigate abortion cases/investigation• What is the King County Prosecuting Attorney’s Office (KCPAO) doing in regard to reproductive health protections?
