	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assault on women and reproductive health care</li> <li>• Right to an abortion is no longer a right or guaranteed</li> <li>• Aware that access vs. ability were different even while Roe v. Wade was codified into law</li> <li>• Impacts on BIPOC communities</li> <li>• Right to privacy, bodily autonomy and individual sovereignty compromised by language in ruling</li> </ul> <p><b>Check-In with members and personal impact</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Responsibility of WAB to be heard</li> <li>• Trying not to get too narrowly focused on abortion because the attack on individual sovereignty and bodily autonomy will continue</li> <li>• Not be complacent about protected status in Washington State</li> </ul> <p><b>King County's response:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sponsored ordinance to DPH – ½ to NWAAF and ½ to DPH</li> <li>• Perry, Kohl-Welles, Zahilay &amp;?</li> <li>• Executive Constantine – KC Executive funds cannot be used to investigate abortion cases/investigation</li> <li>• What is the King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office (KCPAO) doing in regard to reproductive health protections?</li> </ul>
