- Make sure all recyclables are empty, clean, and dry. **NO** liquids or food.
- **NO** bagged recyclable materials. Keep them loose.
- Only put items you know can be recycled in recycling bins. When in doubt, find out.



Sort It Out

Customers who haul their own garbage or recyclable materials to Vashon Recycling & Transfer Station **must separate** the following materials and place them in marked recycling bins or areas.



Corrugated cardboard



Scrap metal

Items with 50% or more metal



Yard waste

No fees are charged to recycle cardboard or scrap metal. The yard waste fee is **less** than the garbage fee.

Yard and food waste

- **Fees apply.** Check in at scale house.
- **Yard waste** includes: Branches, brush, grass clippings, leaves, weeds
- **Food waste** includes: Fruit and vegetable scraps, breads, pastas, bones, fish, meat, poultry, dairy products, egg shells, coffee grounds and paper coffee filters
- These materials are **NOT** accepted with yard and food waste: Glass, metal, plastic, compostable utensils, or food-soiled paper such as pizza boxes, take-out containers, paper napkins, paper towels, or paper plates.

RECYCLE

Place all these materials together in the same recycling bin.

NO liquids or food. All materials must be empty, clean, and dry.

NO bagged recyclable materials. Keep them loose. **NO** plastic bags. **NO** shredded paper.

Paper and cardboard



Cartons, cups, plastic containers



Glass bottles and jars, metal cans



**These materials are collected in separate containers or areas.
Look for signs near each container or area.**

Major appliances



NOT accepted in garbage. Refrigerant-type appliances:
Fees apply. Check in at scale house.


Mercury-containing light bulbs and tubes



NOT accepted in garbage. CFLs, HID bulbs, and fluorescent tubes up to 8 feet in length.
NO incandescent, halogen, or LED bulbs. Limit: 10 bulbs/tubes per vehicle per day.

Mattresses, futons, box springs

\$30 handling fee for each. Check in at scale house. **NO** wet items. Torn or stained items accepted. Limit: Maximum combined total of 6 per customer per day.



Textiles



Clothing, shoes, linens. Torn, worn, stained items accepted.
NO carpets. **NO** wet or mildewed items.

GARBAGE - not accepted in recycling

Paper plates, paper napkins, paper towels

Pizza boxes and other food soiled paper



Shredded paper



Wax-coated cardboard boxes

Types of glass **NOT** accepted for recycling



Ceramics and glassware



Incandescent light bulbs



Windows and mirrors

Types of metal **NOT** accepted for recycling



Aerosol cans



Foil, foil trays, foil paper



Hangers



Paint cans



Sharp objects

Types of plastic **NOT** accepted for recycling



Bubble wrap



Candy wrappers, chip bags



Diapers



Foam



Packing peanuts



Plastic air pillows



Styrofoam blocks



Foam containers and cups



Plastic utensils



Prescription bottles/vials



Plastic bags, baggies, and produce bags



Small caps, lids (less than 3")

Household hazardous wastes

These are products such as paint thinner and pesticides that contain toxic, flammable, reactive, or corrosive ingredients.
