DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

Cedar Grove Composting, Inc. ("Cedar Grove") has applied to the Seattle - King County Department of Public Health for a transfer station facility permit. The permit will authorize Cedar Grove to operate a transfer station on the site of an existing vehicle maintenance and retail site at 7343 East Marginal Way South in Seattle. The transfer station facility will receive organic wastes such as food, wood, yard, and herbivorous animal manure wastes. The facility is currently used as a retail and storage site for finished compost and as a vehicle maintenance and wash site. As proposed, the facility would receive organic wastes indoors and store them for a maximum of 72 hours before the material is transported to a permitted Cedar Grove composting operation in Maple Valley, WA, or Everett, WA. The facility's operations will be authorized under a transfer station facility permit issued by the Seattle – King County Department of Public Health.
