

State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Environmental Checklist

As part of its evaluation of development proposals in unincorporated King County, the Department of Local Services, Permitting Division (Permitting) uses the most current version of the Washington State Department of Ecology's SEPA Environmental Checklist, along with a County-developed Greenhouse Gas Emission Worksheet. Both the SEPA Environmental Checklist and the Greenhouse Gas Emission Worksheet must be submitted for all development permits and land use actions that are not categorically exempt from SEPA environmental review.
