

**I. Purpose**

To repeal Public Rule PUT-8-17-PR, which implemented the fee collection provisions of K.C.C. 27.02.085 mandating the charging of fees for any financial guarantee work performed by the Department of Natural Resources and Parks and Department of Transportation related to storm water drainage facilities and roadway improvements. This rule was established in 2000 and provided a mechanism to bill developers directly for drainage facility inspection fees incurred while a development was in the “maintenance and defect” financial guarantee period. In 2014, the King County Council adopted Ordinance 17682, which repealed K.C.C. 27.02.085 and amended the code (K.C.C. 27.10.570) to recover these charges under a fixed fee through the Department of Local Services, Permitting Division, thereby alleviating the need for Public Rule PUT-8-17-PR.
