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<b>13</b>	Upthegrove/ von Reichbauer	<b>Pacific Raceways Map Amendment.</b> Modifies Map Amendment 9 to modify the uses allowed on the site, the reversion of the zoning to RA-5 if the racetrack use is abandoned, the procedural and substantive requirements for a conservation easement, and a process to undo the changes in the Map Amendment if the requirements of the conservation easement aren't met.
