# CHILDREN AND YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD'S PSTAA SUBCOMMITTEE AT-LARGE MEMBER APPLICATION



### **BACKGROUND**

#### **Request for Candidates**

In accordance with the Implementation Plan for Investment of Puget Sound Taxpayer Accountability Account (PSTAA) Proceeds, which was passed by the full Council on September 1, 2020 as King County Council Motion 15673, the King County Children and Youth Advisory Board (CYAB), will establish a PSTAA Subcommittee to provide guidance to the King County Council and the Executive on the educational needs of King County youth.

#### **Purpose**

The Subcommittee will be composed of not more than 15 individuals, with a majority (at least half plus one) serving as active CYAB members. At-large members will also be recruited to the PSTAA Subcommittee in order to ensure appropriate composition and fill any gaps in experience or representation as outlined in King County Council Motion 15492. Subcommittee members will:

- Monitor the progress of PSTAA implementation in King County;
- Identify opportunities for alignment between PSTAA investments and other key initiatives and programs for children and youth in King County;
- Provide regular updates to the entire CYAB membership;
- Provide guidance to the King County Council and the Executive on the educational needs of King County youth; and,
- Make recommendations on proposed implementation actions and/or revisions to the Implementation Plan.

#### **At-Large Member Responsibilities**

This is a volunteer position. At-large Subcommittee members will be expected to invest 3-5 hours per month participating in: Subcommittee meetings, periodic work groups, review of materials, and consultations with program staff. At-large members must be able to commit to a two-year service term. Meeting times are subject to change but are typically scheduled after 6:00 PM on Tuesdays.

[Please note] At-large Subcommittee members are not subject to executive nomination and council approval to serve on the PSTAA Subcommittee. This is because the Subcommittee derives from CYAB, which is a Council-approved board. At-large Subcommittee members serving on the Subcommittee will be limited in scope to the work of the Subcommittee. They will not be voting members of the CYAB.

#### <u>APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND PROCESS</u>

Application deadline extended through March 1, 2021. Applications received after March 1<sup>st</sup> will be considered in a rolling basis. Please note that recruitment needs will most likely change beyond March 2021.

Interested individuals must **submit a completed application form (starts on page 3).** A résumé may also be included but is not required. Completed application forms can be printed, filled out by hand, and emailed as a PDF attachment; or, they can be typed (including the signature), saved to your computer, and attached to an email.

All candidates must be 16 years old by March 1, 2021.

A review committee composed of CYAB members and King County staff will review and applications. Applicants will be evaluated based on their answers to the questions on the application form, their experience as it relates to the PSTAA prioritized populations, their subject matter experience related to this investment, and their availability to participate in Subcommittee activities.

In order to ensure appropriate composition and fill current expertise and representation gaps within the Subcommittee, this recruitment will prioritize candidates who:

- Have lived or professional experience related to children and youth who are homeless;
- Have lived or professional experience related to children and youth who identify as LGBTQ;
- Have expertise in universal design<sup>1</sup>;
- Are 16-24 years old;
- Identify as Latinx, Pacific Islander, or Native American; and/or
- Live in King County Council Districts 4 or 5.

The candidates that best meet the needs for this recruitment will be invited to participate in an initial interview with a member of the selection panel. A second interview with additional members of the CYAB will follow. All candidates who submit an application by March 1, 2021 will be informed of the result of their application by March 31, 2021.
