

Getting vaccinated with Kaiser Permanente

Steps for getting your COVID-19 vaccine

Washington state authorities have announced that everyone 16 and older will be eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine starting April 15, 2021. Whether you're a Kaiser Permanente member or not, follow these steps to get your vaccine with us once you become eligible. If you are a current or former member, you'll need your medical record number (member ID).

Current or former Kaiser Permanente members:



Sign in at kp.org/wa. No account? Set one up at kp.org/wa/register using your medical record number (member ID).

While not required, filling in the last 4 digits of your Social Security number when you register will let us verify your account and give you access right away.

If you don't have your member ID or need help setting up your account, call Member Services at **1-888-901-4636 (TTY 711)**, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Non-Kaiser Permanente members:



Go to kp.org/covidvaccine and select "Washington." Click on the button under "I'm not a Kaiser Permanente member," then follow the instructions to get set up in the Kaiser Permanente system.

Within a few days, we'll send you an email with your new medical record number. Using your medical record number in the "Member ID" field, create an account at kp.org/wa/register.*

While not required, filling in the last 4 digits of your Social Security number when you register will let us verify your account and give you access right away.

No internet access?

If you do not have internet access, call **1-800-352-3610** to schedule your first vaccine appointment.

After you sign in to your account at kp.org/wa, click on "COVID-19" and complete the "COVID-19 vaccination" e-visit.

Once you have an appointment, go to your appointed location to receive your first shot.

If you're receiving a two-dose vaccine: Once you get your first shot, you'll be scheduled automatically for your second shot.

5

Go to your appointed location to receive your second shot. **Congratulations!** You're now vaccinated against COVID-19.

* Registration is for COVID-19 vaccination purposes only. The COVID-19 vaccine will be provided at no out-of-pocket cost to you (we may bill your insurance company to administer the vaccine). Please follow the prompts for vaccination appointing only. While you may see options for other care access, any other services or care you seek outside of the vaccination will be subject to normal costs and billing.
