Perform the review and approval of preliminary subdivisions and engineer design plans for residential land development. Manage work programs, establish goals and communicate effectively with managers, private consultants and citizen groups. Coordinate and control work assignments, scheduling and perform quality control of engineering work. Evaluate engineering plans for a wide variety of design issues, including drainage control, road design and environmental impacts. Perform fieldwork to evaluate site constraints and land development design criteria. Attend public hearings to provide testimony regarding land use regulations and design standards. Review environmental documents and coordinate issues with multidisciplinary teams. Evaluate required changes and design alternatives to projects and determine the effects on scope of work. Implement various land use regulations including King County Road Standards, surface water design manual, sensitive area codes and state Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). Prepare written reports and correspondence requiring technical or legal explanations.
