Build and maintain doors, window and related hardware including lock mechanisms, closures, keying systems (electronic and mechanical) and re-glazing. Prepare a variety of surfaces for and apply paint or protective coatings to both interiors and exteriors of buildings, facilities and amenities, equipment and furnishings. Operate, clean and maintain various equipment related to the application of paint or protective coatings. Install, relocate and modify equipment and system assemblies; install, attach or brace appurtenances to building walls, ceilings and floors. Design, layout and fabricate various metal components, parts or fixtures used in the repair, maintenance or modification of facilities buildings or equipment. Perform shop and field welding, layout, cutting and fitting. Operate a variety of welding and burning equipment. Install, maintain, repair and modify environmental drainage systems and components. Repair, maintain and monitor HVAC equipment. Plan, schedule and coordinate activities and work with other trades, divisions and outside agencies or contractors.
