In cooperation with the environmental compliance, construction and engineering divisions, develop corrective action, as required, to avoid discharge or spillage of hazardous materials. Periodically inspect metro facilities to identify problem areas. Maintain written and computer generated records and other reports on sampling and testing. Ensure that problem areas have been resolved and monitor compliance. Write reports on construction and facility inspection

activities including problem identification and recommendation for correction. Prepare field notes and sketches as well as photographs and statistical records to document problems. Submit written and telephone reports regarding the progress of programs/projects. Prepare other written reports as requested. Perform other related duties as assigned.
