Maintains a safe clinic environment by adhering to the standards set by Occupational Safety and Health Administration and Washington Industrial Safety and Health Administration (OSHA/WISHA). Assures implementation of these standards at work; follows infection control guidelines; uses techniques of asepsis; disposes safely of biological and clinical materials; and uses appropriate personal protective equipment. Provides patient care based upon these practice guidelines, community standards of care, and Federal and State laws and regulations to ensure compliance with standards, laws, regulations, policies and procedures relating to scope of practice. Participates in activities to evaluate and improve practices, policies, procedures, service delivery models, safety and security measures. Maintains professional competence by pursuing opportunities for continuous learning, attending continuing education offerings, reading professional literature, and engaging in other activities which develop new knowledge and skills.
